INTRODUCTION

Logos:

The header box has 4 corners.

- Make sure that the **NTNU logo** is in one of the corners (like now).
- You may put the **conference logo** in another corner.
- You may also put the logos of all **coauthors' universities** or **funding sources** (like the Norwegian Research Council, etc.) in the remaining corners.

Colors:

- Try to stick to the NTNU colors in your illustrations. The NTNU colors are not well-defined, but as a general rule you can stick to **CMYK: 100-75-0-5** which is NTNU blue.
- If you need more colors, pick **one** of the “supporting colors” described at <http://www.ntnu.no/trykk/ntnu-farger>
- You may also supplement with colors from the other logos you have used in the header...but make sure that the colors fit together!

METHODS

A0 (841mm × 1189mm)

Box width for the **header** box: 80.0 cm
Box width for **2 columns** (as this box): 53.0 cm
Box width for **1 column** (as the intro box): 26.0 cm

(Box separation): 1.0 cm

If you want to split the box vertically (like the discussion/references boxes), make sure that the spacing between them is exactly 1.0 cm.

In this example, I set the height of those boxes to 35.0 cm and 20.0 cm.

Use «Format shape...» -> «Position» to move boxes to a specific position. Make sure that the spacing in all directions is 1.0 cm.

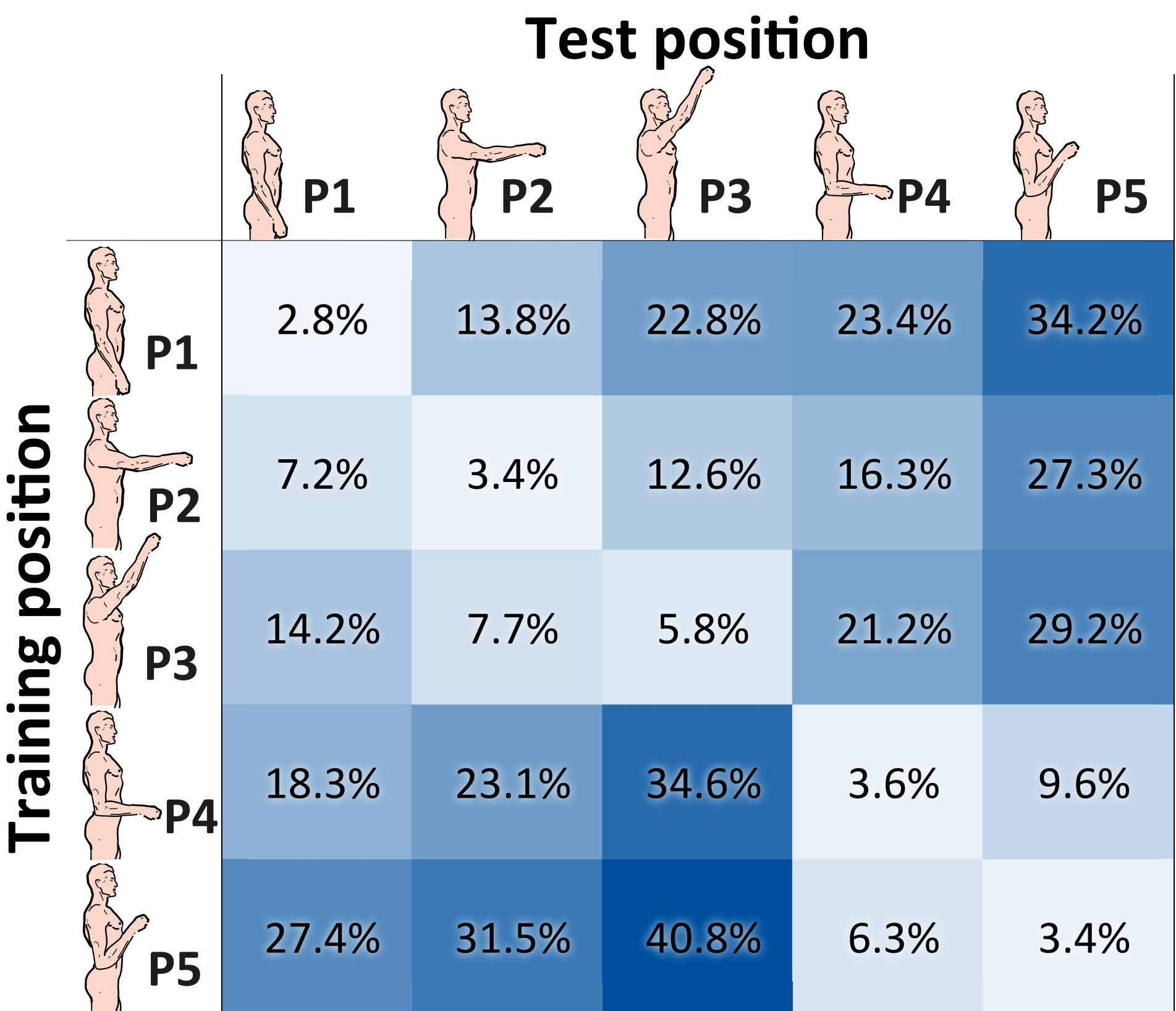
Make sure that you move the subheaders along with the box. To do this in a simple way, you can group them with the box itself (I have already grouped them in this template).

The above line can be used as a **separator** between sections. Move it manually.

You may insert illustrations in **WMF format** if you want the graphics to stay as **vector graphics** in the generated PDF!

Note that these WMF files will look crappy here, but in the PDF they will look nice.
