1. Smart Search

Begin typing in the search bar to get started. AutoSuggest provides related medical ideas and topic pages.

2. Scoped search

Limit results by content type.

3. Filter

Users can filter search results by content type and speciality.

3 Simple Steps to Create a Personal Account


1. Log on directly at www.clinicalkey.com/meded from within your institution's network.

Launch Study Tools

1. Save for later

Fast highlight mode allows you to quickly select passages to review later.

2. Categorise highlights


Categorise key information and notes for future reference. For example, create an 'Exam' category to support your revision.

4. Define public content

Notes and highlights highlighted green are 'public' and can be viewed by any user you've added as a follower.



5. Review your notes

Select 'Review Mode' to review notes and highlights made in specific chapters and customise to create electronic flashcards for each.
