Due to the situation with the corona virus, alternative forms of assessment for upcoming exams are now being established. This means that **we will change from written school exams to home exams, or other form of assessment** that doesn't require physical attendance. In practice, this means that the subject teacher/course coordinator will be able to approve compulsory work requirements, although you haven't completed your planned compulsory work requirements.
