Some points from the meeting:

- General question: "is it enough to read the book (Rausand and Høyland)?" The answer is that the book contains most of the curriculum, see left column of ``Lecture notes and progress''. However, the course also contains stuff that is not covered in the book. (For these topics, there is a blank column to the left in ``Lecture notes and progress''. The lecturer does not require the students to buy the book by Rausand and Høyland, but agrees that a single course book would have been an advantage. Now the slides play the role of the book.
- Regarding Obligatory I: students were mostly happy with these exercises. It took some time to get into Minitab, though. But this effort will be helpful when doing Obligatory 2. Some students commented on the ``by hand'' questions in the exercise. It takes time to write this in Latex. It was possible, however, to submit a handwritten (and scanned) solution here. This option will be made more explicit in the text of Obligatory 2.
