

REPORT FROM FIRST REFERENCE GROUP MEETING

The following points were raised by the class :

- 1) Generally considered a really good lecturer.
- 2) The students would greatly appreciate if Dr. Linder would scan & publish his lecture notes. This will allow students to prepare for the lectures in an efficient manner.
- 3) At times students find it difficult to see what is written on the blackboard. It would be greatly appreciated if the lecturer could read out portions of what is written, or position himself to the left/right of the text he is writing.
- 4) The students appreciate when the lecturer pauses and explains tough concepts thoroughly, as it is both insightful and allows students to catch up with the writing.
- 5) It would be of great help if the lecturer could write a little bigger, especially when approaching the lower half of the blackboard.
- 6) Finally, it would be really helpful if the lecture plan published on the course page, could be expanded in such a way that the students can read up on the relevant sections in the second edition of Griffiths.

The response from the lecturer is as follows :

- 1) I appreciate it – thank you.
- 2) I will start to scan part of the notes and post them successively on the webpage.
- 3) I will position myself on the right side of the text when explaining in order to not block any of the text from sight.
- 4) Noted.
- 5) Noted, although I would also like to see all students move to the front of the lecture hall (the text will be smaller the further back in the room one sits)
- 6) I will add some more details to the lecture plan. It should nevertheless be noted that I cannot know with absolute certainty which exact pages from the textbook that I will cover in a given lecture – I can only indicate it roughly on the webpage.
